we don't live Gita, then what's the point of Gita. Yes, form is important but there are many ways to make yourself happy. Do that!


Spend 10 mins for yourself, with yourself!

Durga Praanaprathista (7th – 14th Feb 2023)

The Durga Ma's Praanaprathista was a momentous milestone in Babaji's mission for the world. In his infinite love for the Divine Mother, the mother herself couldn't resist her presence for Babaji and his devotee's sake. The Praanaprathista was a celebration of the mother's grace with divine chants, hawan's, pooja's, processions, Aarti's, entertainment for the divine, all through the 7 days. There was Joy, love, and peace in the air and in every being's heart.

Day and Night were forgotten, and the only urge was to be present there, live the moment and soak up in the divine energy! The Mother's presence was felt stronger as each day progressed, culminating in her gracing one and all with her physical presence through Divine, Shri Babaji Shivananda. One can imagine the magnitude of this through the 3 divine milestones, The Praanaprathista, The Shiva Parvathi Kalyaanam (celestial wedding) and the 48-day Devi Abhishekam and pooja's that concluded during the Chaitra Navaratri.



Summons of the Mother: A pilgrimage and a blessing of many Life Times...

With blessings of the Mother and Bhagawan Shri Babaji Shivananda, an opportunity of many lifetimes unfolded. There was a strong calling and an urge to welcome the Mother in all grandeur. The first and last I saw her in person was in 2017, the urge to see her only got stronger and stronger as days passed and getting closer to the Praana Prathista. The excitement to meet my Bhagawan, that supreme Brahman, took over and all I could focus on was to handover my commitments before travelling so I could soak myself in thy presence and festivities.

Landing on 5th Feb, reaching my Baba's home was home coming. To meet my family of likeminded is always a True Joy. To witness and be a part of getting the Mother ready for the big festivity, as the very first activity, as I entered was a wonderful start to my 2 week pilgrimage. To catch the first sight of Durga Ma after she was polished and put together, only had me thinking how blessed I was to be there. To have the opportunity to go into Durga Ma's temple, decked in white marble and red curtains, was already energy boosting. All that was ringing on my mind was "I just can't wait to see the Mother seated in her beautiful abode" and certainly must have been the thought of each one assembled there.

The 5th to 7th Feb was exciting as several devotees, family and friends started to arrive. Many of them out of country and some meeting Babaji for the very first time. Also, amongst this

midst, was the family that brought Mother to Life despite the many challenges, difficulties, and tests. A true blessing and an honour to be in the presence of one and all.

On the 5th, an invitation was placed at the Chamunda Devi temple, welcoming her for the Praana Prathista. And so was the invitation to many other deities in Himachal in the previous few days. Prayers were made at the Indru Nag Temple to keep the natural forces (particularly



heavy downpours) at check while the Mother is readied to be invoked.



On the 6th and 7th, The pandals (decorative temporary structures) were getting erected to venerate the Goddess. The skilled workers worked through day and night to transform the place with the best shades of beautiful flowy material, the most exquisite chandeliers, bright lights, and elegant flower decorations. Un-disturbed by any of what was happening on the ground, they had absolute focus on getting the Mothers abode ready in time. We took a walk

along with Babaji to see how our Ashram land was being transformed into a large dining area to host the many thousands in the lead up to the festivities. It was truly fascinating to see it all come to life like the way Babaji and the Mother would have loved it.

On the 7th morning, it was eventful with Mandir clean up, bathing and polishing of all the idols to prepare them for the subsequent days. Hours and hours were spent through the day in grooming them to perfection one could. As we did our work, we sang and swayed to Sankeertans, felt the Joy in the air and Peace within our hearts. Above all, there was the Master to crack us up, inspect our work and lovingly guide us through what needed to be done. The kids, guided by Babaji and others, made the Haven Kund's ready. For most of these kids, bred outside home country, it was first time working with Soil and cow dung. Nevertheless, they joyfully worked on it together!



On the 8th, the poojas, haven's and festivity were to begin in the evening. There was plenty in action this morning, the Nadaswaram players, photo, and video graphers, a big contingent of priests, all from the south, had arrived. Gump's of Flowers made their way from Delhi.

Busses were hired so each one could go along and bring the Jyoth (Sacred Lamp) from Jwaalamukhi Temple as an invocation of the mother. No ghee, no oil, no wick, no fire, no smoke, no heat, no gas, yet the flame has been burning for centuries in this Shakti Peet.

To the accompaniment of the Nadaswaram artists, Babaji, family and devotees made their way to this wonderous temple. The Offerings were made by Babaji, the Aarti performed, and the lamp lit which was eventually to be

brought back home.

say, it was a **sight to watch** the Nadaswaram players welcome Shri Babaji Shivananda and Jwaalamukhi Ma (Jyoth) back home. It was tears of happiness experienced to see the lamp being taken into the Mother's Mandir (abode) and **the first Aarti performed**. It is the beginning of a renewed and exciting journey ahead, a momentous occasion for Babaji and



for everyone with him. The time has arrived and only time can reveal everything on this mission to us. So much excitement in store!

While it was action packed at the temple, there was enough bustle at the Home of Babaji where the proceedings were going to happen. The pandits arrived to set things needed for the Pooja that evening. Whilst working with the pandits, the compassionate lord made sure to check on those who couldn't join the Jwaalamukhi temple darshan and join him over a video call. What a Master and how grateful could one be to be in his divine fold and Love.

The excitement for the start of the evening pooja had already set in. The sacred Havan Kunds were lit and Havan performed to sanctify the place. **The evening kicked off with the sacred Maha Ganapathi and Vaastu pooja.**

The **Shobha yatra**, a procession of the deity (Devi Ma), accompanied by musicians and dancing, was taken along the streets around the Mandir.









The evening concluded with tying of the rakshabandhana (tying of the sacred thread on everyone) and the Maha Mangala Aarti.





9th Feb, Thursday morning, started at 4.30 am with morning ablations, cleaning of the Mandirs and space where haven's were to happen. As devotees started to fill up the space, the Gods and Goddesses were entertained by the Nadaswaram artists. As the priests made their morning preparations, Babaji arrived to get the pooja's and haven's started.

The morning saw the **Kalash Sthapana** (a pot filled with water and adorned with a decorated coconut representing Mother Goddess) being performed.

The **Bimba shudhi and Maha Ganapati Navagraha haven** was also performed this morning.



The **first Kalash and Devi Abhishekam** was performed. As Babaji and family performed the Devi Abhishekam, devotees gathered also had their opportunity to perform the Abhishekam to the beautiful Devi Ma for the first time.

The morning concluded with the Maha Aarthi followed by the Maha prasad. **The surging energy could be felt by one and all**. The powerful rush of emotions was natural and there was no reason for the shedding of tears! The Master and the Goddess were working their

magic on us for sure!



By now, the flow of the day was understood. The sumptuous afternoon meal, post lunch clean-up of the space in preparation for the evening session, some rest and back to evening pooja was on cards. The evening saw an enjoyable Bhajan session by the Kalyani brothers post which the Maha Ganpati puja, Veda chanting, Nitya Havan, Kalash puja, and Aarti was performed.

Prior to the Aarti, as part of the shodaupachara Pooja, the Nadaswaram players cranked up their best to please the lord as the raaga was called by the priests. It was a treat to the ears, and this was now a part of the morning and evening Pooja's prior to Aarti. It was followed by the Himalayan artists at work, which was as pleasing to the ears and the dak players took us to yet another world. What a wonderful evening it was, each one played their part in appeasing the Goddess.



10th Feb, Friday, was Kangra day, a significant day for Babaji and for us devotees. Swami first made his presence on this day @ 7.15 pm and hence were set to perform a Paada Pooja for Babaji.

The Flower decorators overnight had adorned the whole place with very special flower decorations and Garlands.

The morning as usual was a 4.30 am start with cleaning all the areas to begin the day with Maha Ganapati puja, Devi Abhishekam, Kalash puja, Chandi haven and Kanya Puja.



On this day, each one present got to perform the abhishekam to both the mother and the Kalash. There was calmness and stillness while performing the abhishekam today as compared to the previous day.

Each day had a different Chakra Rangoli drawn by the Priest based on the Pooja and Havan that was to be done. The ladies worked together in devotion to get the offerings ready for the much-awaited Chandi haven.





The **Chandi haven** is performed to receive the blessings of Goddess Chandi Devi and to eliminate all obstacles. The chandi

haven was beautifully performed with offerings into the haven at the conclusion of each chapter of Devi Paraayanam. The pundit's chants, accompanied by high energy Nadaswaram, Dak & Himachali artists at the time of making the offering to the Goddess, did something

unexplainable!

While the Chandi Havan was happening, the **Kanya pooja** was performed to little kids from the neighbouring vicinity. As innocent they could be, it was a treat watching them enjoy all the offerings.





The morning wound up as the Nadaswaram, Dak and Himachali artists presented their superlative skills to delight the Goddess and enthral the audience. Each time they played; they gave their finest!







The afternoon had plenty to clear and scrub but well finished in time for the evening Pooja. Babaji was tired for the Paada Pooja and hence moved to another day post the festivities concluded. With due respect to Babaji's and everyone else's tiredness, it was the best to do although slightly disappointing it could not be done on the very special day!



The evening pooja began with **Lalitha Sahasranama pooja** performed by all the ladies gathered. It was cool, calm, serene, still! A true expression of Divinity. The mother's presence was experienced within and outside, as the Kumkum Archana began with the 1000 names of the Devi Lalitha recited. Some experienced, Guru Babaji, as the divine Mother and performed the Archana to his

feet. While the

Paada pooja could not be physically performed to the Guru's feet on this special occasion, in all his compassion, he granted transcendent moments of pure Joy. He is the real Mother, to the many who were gathered that evening!

The evening concluded with the Mangala Aarti by Babaji. As Swami's Aarti was in progress, a flash thought led devotees to perform the Aarti for Babaji too on this special occasion.

It was Gratitude in abundance to the gracious Guru to grant each one's wish on this day!





The 11th Feb, Saturday, started with the routine cleaning but with aplenty to have done prior to the morning pooja. There was help galore to have it all in place with his grace.


The morning again started with Devi Abhishekam, Kalash puja, Mahalakshmi haven and concluded with Aarti. The place brimmed with people, positivity, and love. This morning, the Vishnu Sahasranamam was chanted together.

All the 3 haven's went live at the same time and Agni devata, the primordial lord of fire, rose tall granting one and all the blessings of the Mother. The smoke from the Havens engulfed us into another new world and one could not but miss the special moment of Babaji manifesting 4 gold coins to offer into the haven during the Poornahuti. Shri Babaji, in all humility sat aside in trance, prior to finishing up the morning with the Maha Mangala Aarti.

The evening saw some bhajans, haven's and a dance performance to entertain the Goddess. Devotees were allowed into the Sanctum Sanctorum to take a Sankalpa and offer their offerings into the Garbha Griha over which the Little Mother will be seated, signifying the energy connection with her always. Babaji initiated it by manifesting a gold chain and the rest followed. It was fascinating to watch each one offer whatever they had on them to the Mother. While this took a while for each one to have their turn, Babaji sat in patiently blessing each one. This was followed by dinner.

Post dinner, there were a few major events that happened impromptu as directed by the priests.

- Firstly, the Mother was rested on a bed of flowers and fruits.
- The kumbham, the crown of the temple, was to be installed atop the temple.
- Lastly the Garbha Griha had to be sealed and the Mothers, small and Big, were to be





The Kumbham was taken to the top, amidst unknown Joy and chants of Bole Baba ki jai and Jagadambe maya ki Jai. It was a sight to watch Shri Babaji, the priests, and few others atop. As this completed, the priests had the boiling hot mix ready to seal the Garbha Griha and have the little Mother seated ready for the Pratishtaan the following day.

While all of this was happening, Babaji and a small set of sevaks were at work getting Mother Mahishasura Mardini, ready to be carried into her sthaan at the Mandir. Full throated Devi kirtans began, and they kept flowing with renewed energy for the next hour as we witnessed the Mother being carefully carried into the Mandir amidst chants of Jai Mata di and Ambe Mata. As all parts of the full set up was transported into the Mandir, the doors were shut.

I could not wait to see the Mother in her abode. The energy could not be explained as it was all happening. The Mandir opened and Babaji in all his love announced a 5 min darshan. Those present took their blessings in bated breath; it was overwhelming to see the Mother in her sthaan back after many years. What a sight to behold and what a night to cherish! Babaji

had the Mandir doors closed for the night so the Mother and all present could retire.

Babaji was in his elements, and one could just see how joyful he was. It was a few hours before waking up for the next day and plenty to do in the next couple of days. It was nothing but her strength and Babaji's love and grace that kept each one going.

12th Feb, Sunday, was the big day that each one was waiting for. **The Praana Prathista**. Each day leading to this day has been memorable and filled each one to the core. All that was on my mind, was to see the Mother in her full shringaar. I had no idea what was otherwise planned.

The morning began with a ceremony of seeing the Mother through a mirror and not directly through naked eyes. Each one made their way and had that beautiful moment to have that

first glance. Clad in a simple cotton yellow saree, she sparkled through the doors of her new Home. No Jewellery, No shringaar, No Flowers, yet she already looked majestic in her beautiful and lovingly built home.

While this was happening, felt sprinkles of cold water and looked up to see our beloved Babaji showering us with blessings as the puja to the Kumbham was being performed. The Maha Ganapati puja, Go-puja and Durga Haven followed.



It was time for the **Final Maha Poornahuti**. As the Nadaswaram players were signalled to play and Babaji was handed the offerings for the Maha Poornahuti, the energy was palpable and the atmosphere ethereal. In minutes, emerged, the glorious mother from Agni (the fire God), choosing Shri Babaji as her medium and navigating him straight into the Sanctum Santorum, with all her might and force. Nothing could hold him back. It was my first experience and caught unaware of what I should be feeling. It was the mother, but the only thought that stayed was that Babaji feel fine. As Babaji entered the Mandir, we lost visibility to what was happening. The atmosphere was filled with Her Energy, each one had varied

emotions to work through. As the mother invoked herself into the idol, Babaji was brought out to be seated and to conclude the magnificent event. The Nadaswaram players played at their highest peak and it was intense.

The kumbha abhishekam began, and blessings of cool waters, chocolates and flowers showered from atop.

To conclude, Babaji blessed each one with sprinkles of the holy water and the Maha Mangala Aarti was performed.



While people were ushered for lunch, Abhishekam of the mother was being performed in the



mandir. Mother couldn't be any happy and visibly showed through her beautiful smile. Each one was a moment that could not have been forgotten, Babaji earned everything through his Love for the Mother and unending Patience. I stayed on, not wanting to miss anything and just be in HIS and HER presence.

Shri Babaji went into the Mandir, to do the Mother's

Shringaar himself despite all the tiredness. Many waited to see Mother in her full Shringaar. It was a couple of hours, the

doors opened for darshan, and all sights on her. None could take their eyes of her. What a moment and feast to the eyes it was! All the time could be passed in joy, just watching her. Everything just felt lighter.

With very little time for evening Aarti by the Bengali Pandit, there was exhaustion and tiredness, but equally delightful to watch the Aarti and see Babaji down for his Mother and Devotees.



As the bengali Aarti was complete, the Dak players and the Himalayan artists played their



hearts full, and devotees requested Babaji to shower us with his graceful dancing. Shri Babaji on request, danced away in his most elegant style. The evening built up with everyone joining in the dancing. It was a celebration, a commemoration in honour of the Mother's home coming. It was a little glimpse of Durga Pooja is what i was told. Plenty of rejoicing and exhilaration!

It was dinner time, and for many of us, it was the 1st meal of the day but no discomfort whatsoever. Gratified by everything we had got to see and rejoice over the last few days and specifically this day! With a little more than 3-4 hrs, before we wake up for the next day's big clean-up prior to the Shiv ji and Parvathi ji's Kalyaanam (celestial wedding), we retired for the day.

13th Feb, Monday, the whole space was re-done so it could seat devotees for the Celestial wedding. The Deities, Shiv Ji and Parvathi Mata were well groomed for the auspicious occasion, beautifully draped, and adorned with choicest ornaments. Shri Babaji was all along in the Mandir making sure everything was in place.

As everything was set to take the deities on a procession, the women led the procession with offerings of Haldi, Kumkum, Holy waters, Fruits, Sweets, Coconuts, Clothes, Jewellery and many more while the men carried the Divine mother and father.





The procession was carried out into the inner most streets surrounding the Mandir to the accompaniment of Nadaswaram, dak and Himalayan artists. As we returned, the divine couple were welcomed with the traditional braking of the coconut, Nadaswaram and Aarti. As the couple were seated, we took our seats too. Crowds from all over thronged the place. It was at full absolute capacity. Observing the celestial wedding was new to many. I couldn't dare to think a wedding could be so joyful.







The danceful exchange of garlands and a play with the flower ball between the deities was adorable to watch. The pundits were at their best in keeping one and all wrapped in attention and the audience were heartily entertained. It was an enjoyable and delightful experience for those present.

The tying of the sacred knot was heavenly, and the proceedings thereafter were sublime.



The morning thus brought us to the end of the divine unison. The conclusion of this whole event was a state of being with God!

This was followed by a **kangri bandara**, a feast that saw 100's of people being fed. The feast had the best of kangri curries served and each one ate to their hearts content. As we sat for the feast which we thought was the last batch to conclude the bandara, there still were scores of people, elderly, mid-aged, young, and tiny tots making their way to enjoy the feast.

Between 14th and 17th Feb, the pundits were seen off beautifully and so were the



Nadaswaram, Dak and Himalayan musicians. The warmth and respect with which each one was treated and facilitated by Shri Babaji was a treat to the eye. In observance, it was true humility to learn from. The Master always mentioned, "respect is to come from the heart". It was truly a heartful send-off while we followed the Master and the pundits to the bus stand from where the journey was to be made to their respective homes.

There were plenty of Satsangs, informal and formal to cherish. Particularly for me, Babaji's intense journey and sacrifices along the way for the sake of showing us thy self were painful to hear and would turn one emotional. But it only re-iterated to us, the immense sacrifices the Master continues to make for our sake and the magnitude of effort and sacrifices we need

to make to hold onto him in our hearts and move forward in our journey. **Thy mission is our mission!**

18th Feb was **Shivarathri**, The Mandirs were cleaned abhishekam performed to all the idols.

The Rudrabhishekam was performed by the priest. It was scorching heat but did not deter anyone from participating in the pooja and Abhishekam to the Shiva Lingam. Some fasted and others lunched and rested post to stay afresh for the nights jaagran.

Babaji kick started night with Kirtans at night, and it travelled through difference voices and tunes with instruments added as we went along. We lost track of time and the night, isn't Shivarathri all about that? Babaji announced we would do Aarti at 2.00 AM instead of going to morning since everyone was tired. Trials were made on behalf of everyone assembled to extend the bhajans to early morning, but nothing seemed to work with summons from the loving master to wind up. In all, it was a night to treasure. A Shivarathri with Lord Shiva himself, in the presence of the Mother and at the Guru sthaan that Babaji revered. A long-time wish fulfilled and could not have asked for anymore.

27th March was the Final day of the 48-day long Devi Abhishekam and formally concluded the whole Praana Prathista event. Unto this day, Shri Babaji lovingly made garlands, performed the Abhishekam, spent time doing the Devi Alankaram and dressed her up in a variety of styles each day. Babaji also blessed one and all with glimpses of her each day post the pooja was performed. As magnificent as HIM, was Devi Ma in all her splendour and beauty. On the 27th of March, was a grand celebration to conclude the festivities and the Mothers Sthapana.







A blessing indeed it was, to be a part of this ethereal celebration. Jai Baba! Jai Ma! Without their anugraha (blessing), it would have remained a distant dream. In all gratitude, bow down to thee. There's possibly no word in the dictionary to express this gratitude and Love!

Experience the Truth

Maa Durga: Paresh, Mumbai

My loving Pranams at the lotus feet of our Divine Mother – Maa Durga. Maa is omnipresent, omnipotent, omniscient, the source of divine love and the supreme personification of eternal bliss.

The following notes are my learnings, observation and understanding from various experiences I've had. Some of the experiences have been truths mentioned by our compassionate Babaji in his talks.



- Ψ Maa Durga is our highest self, present within each of us.
 - We were all gathered by Maa to experience Her divine energy and love. Maa has bestowed upon us this connection with Her, which is true and the highest wealth that no being can ever rob or replace. Our presence mattered to Maa and was expressed by her on several occasions during the puja. Maa communicates with all of us through words, gestures, and the heart.
- Ψ Maa Durga's Pratishtaan is a reminder to all of us that we need to let go of all the burdens, false assumptions, resentments, guilt, and expectations we have created for ourselves. When we overcome these, we respect Maa's existence in our lives by giving her the importance we ought to.

Ψ Maa is that:

Strength that helps us desire and choose the right purpose or goal Strength that brings the right knowledge and wisdom to achieve these goals Strength that helps us accomplish these goals (physical and mental strength, for a human to perform any action)

Maa is that

Truth and the Final Destination!



 ψ Maa is present in all three states – Sattva, Rajas, and Tamas, and She alone can connect us with Herself if we have the slightest desire and make the slightest effort to connect with her. Furthermore, she's always the giver, whatever we present to her (through thought, prayer, action) proliferates, whether it's from a Sattvic, Rajasic or Tamasic state of mind - it is provided to us instantly and abundantly. Whatever may be our state of mind, at any time, we surrender that to Her.

 ψ A place where Maa's energy is respected (like, during the puja) will expose our defects to us in clarity. She guides. Listen to her and follow her message instantly with respect. She speaks to us in the language of love (not limiting the nature of the speech of love to sweet voices or

soft speech within the mind). Her messages are only for our betterment and the benefit of the entire creation. She loves all unconditionally.

Ψ She teaches us, tests our progress, and is present during the test in any form, and She is the one rewarding us for our success in the situation provided by her. Abide by and practice all that She's taught us - even in the toughest, unbelievable tests conducted by her. There's always a deeper meaning behind what our senses perceive, and our minds understand initially. She is the only one we shouldn't fear and can be approached in all moods.

Life is a precious gift given to us by Maa to experience the bliss She is, live it with Maa's divine love, peace, guidance, and joy. If we wait for others (in past, in present, in future) who determine our happiness, or if we postpone living our lives due to reasons, we're not valuing Maa's gift.

- Ψ Live in the present. Be content and happy, let go of the past and accept yourself as you are with happiness. Maa is the embodiment of all the right and good. Let Maa do her divine work in Her way as She knows what She's doing and doesn't require any suggestions.

I booked the flight ticket to Kangra on 18th Jan for 8th Feb to attend the Durga Prana Pratishta. After booking the ticket, I was bedridden for 4 days and had to cancel the flight. I was feeling sad for cancelling the ticket. Just 4 days before the commencement of the function, I rebooked the flight for 7th February irrespective of my illness and put all faith in Babaji and Swami and left.

When I was about to reach Babaji's house at about 2.30 in the afternoon, to my surprise, Babaji was standing alone in the main entrance of His house, as if waiting for us. As soon as He saw me coming with other devotees, Babaji told me that He was very happy about my coming.

When I entered the abode of Babaji, I lost myself and felt that I was in Shiv lok or Vaikuntam, whatever it may be. The full area of Babaji's house was decorated with different types of pandals with beautiful colours and chandeliers. One side had mild music on Devi, on the other side, some devotees already landed there and, on another side, Babaji was enjoying with devotees. One cannot express the grand Divine atmosphere amidst the Himalayan Range. It was not an ordinary place like a choultry decorated, but a Divine place with cool breeze filled with Shakti, Divine vibrations, and happiness.



From 8th to 13th February, the whole atmosphere was filled with Nadaswaram on one side, Veda gosh in front of the Havan, and the sudden appearance of Babaji with Divine Smile before the commencement of the function, talking to each one who were present there. A Journey with HIM: Many a first-time experience

Experience Sharing 1: Father Philip Kuruvilla (Bangalore)

Food for a spiritual journey...

In 1983, at the age of 32, I left my home and my life as a businessman, sportsman and a socialite in the then happening city of Kolkata, to search for God. I hitchhiked across Europe, USA, Australia, and New Zealand. My journey took me to many places all over the world. I got a post graduate degree from Oxford University, and I worked among the marginalised, that included HIV Positive people and members of the LGBTI communities. During this time, I was ordained as a minister/priest of the Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church and worked as a Youth Facilitator. I also met and married my wife Bibi, and we have 2 beautiful children, Maria, and David.

Fast forward 30 years: My wife Bibi had come home one evening in early 2022 from a Satsang in Bangalore, where she went with a friend, and she talked about this young Guru she had met there. Then in the months that passed, I heard her praising this Guru on many occasions. I know my wife is not easily impressed by faith leaders, and it crossed my mind that there must be something special about this person. Later in the year, my wife and daughter joined a small entourage that visited Kangra in HP and the house of the Guru, who was known as Shivananda Swami, or more simply, as 'Babaji'. The conversation in our house also reflected this new phenomenon. Quoting from his talks about other faiths, Bibi and I often discussed the proximity of Jesus' life and sayings to some of the teachings of ancient seers. Was Jesus' message to the whole Universe now enclosed and encapsulated in such a way to be palatable only for the Christian faithful, the children of an Abrahamic, monotheistic God?

Then in early 2023, Bibi and Maria, my daughter, received invitations to attend a 'Devi Sthapana' in the home of Babaji in Kangra. Since it was few days before Shivaratri, they decided to stay on for that as well, and asked me if I would like to join - it would be a good opportunity to meet Babaji. It was with more than a little trepidation that I agreed. The real fear was that it was still very, very, cold in Delhi and HP, and being a good southerner by my DNA, I was quite concerned whether I would be able enjoy anything at all, if I was freezing. The weather Gods were in my favour and the temperature went up just as I reached Delhi and took the overnight bus to Kangra. Maria met me at the bus stop, and I proceeded to Kanchan's home where we were to stay for the next few days. Kanchan was a true 'pahadi' [mountain dweller] who opened her house to strangers because Babaji asked her to, but she opened her heart to us - because that's the kind of person she was! I was told that Babaji was unwell after the 5 days of puja and was resting. I had a nap in the sun, and it was lunchtime that we went over to Babaji's house to join a few others for a simple meal. During the meal, cooked and served by his sister-in-law and other relatives, I saw Babaji for the first time. Though I had seen several photographs earlier, I saw this pleasant, handsome, young

man with a beard and matted hair who joined us, sitting cross-legged on the ground for the meal. When our eyes met, I gave a respectful namaste, and he acknowledged with a smile.

In the 3 days after that, we had several occasions to listen to him, and also when on two occasions he gave us a private audience. While elaborating about kriya yoga, albeit upon Bibi's insistence, he took us into yoga and philosophy. During his discourses and teachings, I feel I gained insights which can only come from a truly spiritual guide. On Shivaratri, Babaji had organised a Satsang in his courtyard. About 50 people had come together - there were some rustics from his village, others included old women, families, couples, a smattering of foreigners and some young techies, all seekers - and they kept singing bhajans till about 2 am. In between Babaji gave a discourse in Hindi. While finding it personally amusing that an Indian Orthodox Christian priest was present at the foothills of the Himalayas to join in Shivaratri bhajans, I enjoyed every moment.

In these encounters, what touched me most about Babaji was his innate simplicity, and humility. When he walked around his house or led the bhajans or sat on an [ordinary] chair and gave his discourses, it was about the simplest of things told in a very simple way-which anyone could grasp - much like the barefoot teacher I call 'Lord' and 'Master' - viz., Jesus Christ. No pomp, no show, no jargon, no hype. And, he spoke of the Sanatana Dharma, which was India's faith-heritage gift for all her children, regardless of their faith. How all faiths ultimately led to the ocean of God's divine presence. Of how, it was love and service that overcame the barriers and divisions.

In these messages by themselves, I must admit I found nothing new that seers and sages had not said before, but he put them forward to his rapt listeners to remind them of their duties to others through service, especially to the fallen, the downtrodden and marginalised. I've had the experience of sitting in small and large Satsangs with other, more well-known Hindu faith leaders like His Holiness Sri Sri Ravi Shankar in the Art of Living centre in Bangalore, and with Pujya Chidananda Swami on the banks of the Ganga in Rishikesh, where there were far greater number of devotees. Their styles, their approaches were different, and much in contrast to this home-grown guru who was explaining his Universe to those who cared to listen. As a Christian, with experience in listening to other faith leaders on various platforms and podiums in India and abroad, I was keenly listening for anything out of the ordinary, but also for words by which the speaker would seal off a certain area for 'his' people, from 'others', [ie., those not from his religion]. I listened for something hidden in his words which would ultimately make his followers 'exclusive' and take them to a place where I, as a practicing Christian, could not follow. However, on reflection, there was nothing in his words that I could not agree with, nothing that would contravene my ideas of the Triune God, as I knew and understood Him, though through a 'Christian lens' and a different theology and language.

I wondered whether the Message of Jesus Christ - the Evangelion or the Good News - to the world, which was brought to India by one of his 12 disciples, Thomas, in 52 AD, was originally meant to have been much more open and more inclusive, especially in the ancient land of Sanatana Dharma? That message attracted our forefathers enough to convert them to

Christianity. However, has it been, over the last 2000 years, narrowed down by our faith leaders and theologians, till today it remains a "closed" religion which gives little space for true seekers who wish to follow the Spirit and seek beyond its borders? Was our proud "Syrian Christian heritage" blocking us from receiving the fullness of Christ's divinity in this ancient land, and also from giving His message to others in a way more easily appreciated and understood by our countrymen? It set me wondering whether a "different" Indian Christian theology could yet be developed which was not limited by Syrian, Catholic or Protestant Christian exclusivity, but instead could be offered in a different way in this sacred land so acceptable of other faiths and philosophies?

Thank you for opening my mind and heart at this crucial time Babaji. I come away from your presence confused as to what my future course of thought and action will be, but I continue my search with your blessings.

I am emboldened by the words of the Spanish mystic saint, Migel Unamuno, who wished his followers thus: "May God deny you peace, but give you glory".

Every woman present was to draw that courageous power and dedication to Divinity from Ma's inexhaustible treasure of blessings. Who could in all honesty, ever go back to mundane living! After being drowned for 3 days in this romantic interlude of the Creator Baba and his very own Cosmic creation. 
